Is it legal to disconnect from a solar power system?

However, you may encounter legal issuesif you want to disconnect from the electric system completely. State law requires homes within 300 feet of a power line to have "electric service." It's unclear whether this "electric service" can be your solar power system. Further, some laws make it illegal to live in a home without any power at all.

Solar access laws allow residents to install solar, even if they live in an HOA. Laws vary by state, from guaranteeing residents of HOAs the right to put up solar panels to outlining just how far an association can go in controlling the design and implementation of a solar system.
